University General Education Course Equivalencies
2002-2004

Students who successfully complete the Core Curriculum of the Honors College automatically satisfy all of the General Education Core Requirements, (Pg. 34 Undergraduate Catalog). In order to earn the designation of University Honors Scholar, students must complete 30 HON prefixed credits, maintain a 3.0 Honors GPA and a 3.3 UNLV GPA. They must also enroll in a minimum of one HONORS course per semester.

ENGLISH (9 Credits) Honors students complete one composition and two literature courses. HON 100 is equivalent to ENG 102 and therefore ENG 101 is not required. HON 106 & HON 115 can be taken in any order. Honors students must complete HON 100 by the end of their **first** year.

ENG 101→ENG 102→ENG LIT

HON 100→HON 106→HON 115

CONSTITUTIONS (3 Credits) HON 111 and HON 112 are three credit courses; however they do satisfy both US and Nevada Constitution.

HIST 100→HON 111 OR PSC 101→HON 112

HUMANITIES (6 credits):

HON 110 and one special topic HON 400H; or any regular course that meets the university's definition of humanities.

COMPUTER OR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY REQUIREMENT

HON 125 (or satisfaction of this requirement via approved course or computer information technology experience within major.)

MATH (3 Credits)

HON 141H OR HON 181H (one semester of calculus MATH 181 or Higher)

MATH 181→HON 181, MATH 182→HON 182

Honors College offers HON 181(Calculus I) every Fall and HON 182(Calculus II) every Spring.

SCIENCES (7-8 Credits) Honors College students are required to complete 11 credits of science credits in at least two disciplines, including two courses with laboratories.

HON 230(4) and HON 235(4) as well as one other university approved non-lab science course (3).

Lab Science→HON 230(Physics and Chemistry) or HON 235(Biology and Geology)

LOGIC (3 Credits)

HON 140H OR THREE SEMESTERS OF CALULUS THROUGH MATH 283, OR MATH 132, PHIL 102(HON 102), OR PHIL 105, OR PHIL 109.

FINE ARTS (3 Credits) HON 210 or one special topics HON 400 or an approved course from the catalog. Certain courses may also satisfy the multicultural or international requirement.

HON 400 MUST HAVE BEEN TAKEN BEFORE FALL 2006 TO COUNT AS FINE ARTS.

SOCIAL SCIENCE (9 Credits)

Two HON 400 Seminars can be used to satisfy 6 Credits of Social Science.

HON 200X or approved social science → HON 400→HON 400

200A=PSY 101, 200B=ECON 102, 200C=ECON 103, 200D=SOC 101, 200E=ANTH 101
